Dear Friends and Co-Laborers in Christ,

The churches here send their greetings to you, the churches in America. The churches here pray for the churches in the United States and thank God for your obedience and faithfulness in the Great Commission. As the churches here learn more about the task of missions, they appreciate more and more the sacrifices you have made.

There are those within the churches who have a continued desire to reach others with the Gospel. This is so encouraging to see. One young man asked if I would go evangelizing with him and his wife each week to various communities. Of course I am thrilled to do so. Another man has the Gospel clearly posted in his barbershop and has regular discussions with the patrons and other barbers. A young lady is always concerned with encouraging other ladies who have a rough home situation with visits and sending messages. Two men work together in scheduling meetings with various government groups within their community and preach the Gospel to them and present them with Bibles. There is much other evangelistic activity that takes place, some very regularly and others periodically. We are very pleased to see the desire to reach others with the Good News of Jesus Christ.

In November, God opened the doors for the completion of the Boa Vista School Project. We were originally scheduled to complete this in September, but we were delayed time and time again. While this was quite frustrating for us, looking back now we see that it was the hand of God. During October, there were several events of demonic activity within the schools. Events that emptied classrooms, sent people to the hospital by the dozens for unknown issues, events that had the people terrified. When we arrived and were offering something the opposite of what they had been experiencing, the schools were very receptive to us. We had complete liberty in the schools and were able to preach the clear Gospel message in every classroom on the island along with giving each student, teacher, and staff a school packet. These school projects have been a project of PREACH Evangelistic Ministries for many years that are the results of much time, finances, and effort exerted both in the US and here in Cape Verde. I pray God continues to keep the doors open to continue these in the future.

As the year draws to a close, we have been reflecting on what God has done here and how to build on that in the year to come. While we face many trials and tribulations, the blessings also abound abundantly. We thank God for you for being some of the blessings we have in our life.
