We did not get an exact count, but we believe we had between 40-60 people attend from the community.

In March our family had the opportunity to be a part of the BIMI field conference with most of the USA missionary Church Planters. This was a time of fellowship and spiritual encouragement. We were certainly humbled by the generosity of the church that hosted this conference as well as the leadership at BIMI.

We are anticipating a busy schedule coming up in May and June. We certainly covet your prayers for wisdom and guidance as we execute these plans.
