An Update From The Kidd Family

Dear Friends and Co-Laborers in Christ,

I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, Phil 1:3. As we look back on 2025 and all that God has done, we can't help but think of the many who lift us up in prayer and financially support the ministry here in Cape Verde and thank our great and mighty God for you all.

God worked in many different ways here during 2025, but here are some of the highlights:

The year began finishing preparations for a large medical mission held in January. We were blessed to receive a group from PREACH and from Operation Renewed Hope to complete 4 days of clinics. While the days were long and hectic, it was a blessing to be able to minister both physically and spiritually to multitudes of people. I was very proud to see the churches here jump in and serve in any capacity they could. While we did not see many salvations, much seed was planted and the love of Christ was plainly demonstrated. We leave the increase in God's hands.

We also completed a school Scripture distribution project in September on the island of São Nicolau. A team from PREACH also came over to work with us on this project. With the help of our Lord, we were able to deliver our school kits (each kit includes a New Testament) to over 3,000 students, teachers, and staff. In most of the classrooms we were given opportunity to briefly share the Gospel of Christ. Over the years PREACH has distributed approximately 300,000 of these kits in the schools here in Cape Verde and we plan to continue as long as the doors of opportunity stay open.

The 3 churches that we work with each have their own struggles, but God is still working. They each have a national pastor leading them and I have been in a role of teaching and offering guidance and counsel. The soil here is hard, but we continue to plant seeds and pray for God to work in the hearts of the people.

The seminary classes have been continuing. We started the year with 4 men studying. 1 had to be removed as a matter of church discipline and 2 are taking a break for various reasons. The man currently studying has been faithfully preparing for several years to be a pastor. The Lord willing, when we return from furlough I will work with him on another church plant. Please pray for Pascoal as he finishes his seminary studies and spiritually prepares for the work ahead.

We are in the process of finalizing our furlough plans. If we have not already scheduled a meeting and you would like us to visit your church to report on the ministry here, please contact me via either email or phone listed below under Personal Contact. We are available for meetings between May and December of 2026.
