My son Ithiel-James is excelling in his kindergarten classes and is preparing to graduate to first grade soon. Our youngest, Candace, is also doing well and getting ready to start K4 in August. However, my wife recently experienced the loss of a two-month pregnancy, which has been a difficult time for her. Church Ministry

God continues to bless our church, with 150 souls saved in the first quarter of this year and 25 visitors in attendance. Our congregation is growing both spiritually and numerically, and we currently have three students in Bible training, who all came to faith through Fellowship Baptist Church Akure, thanks to your support.

One of our Bible students will soon be marrying a young lady from our church, which is a joyous occasion for us all.

New Church Plant (Fellowship Baptist Church Ijare)

Our new church plant-building project is ongoing, and we have received tremendous support to start this work. However, we are still trusting the Lord for more helping hands to continue building the church. We are currently using a school classroom for our services, but we hope to have enough funds soon to put a roof on the church.

Please pray for this project as we face opposition from those who do not believe in the gospel. We firmly believe that the gospel has the power to save sinners, and we trust in the Lord's guidance and strength.

The Bible Yoruba Audio Project

We are still working on the audio Bible project, and we have completed the New Testament and started recording the Book of Psalms in the Old Testament. Please pray for strength to complete the editing of this project.

Radio Ministry

We are also trusting the Lord for our radio ministry, which reaches over 50,000 people weekly across five neighboring states in our local language. It is an urgent need for our church, as it will make it easier for me to preach at both churches and take our members on soul-winning trips.
