His name was supposed to be Charles James Bundy; however, here the middle name is always the father's name, and the last name is the father's middle name (which should be the grandfather's name). My middle name is not my father's name, so already there's a little bit of an issue...they wanted his name to be Charles Timothy Charles! So, we spent two weeks at many offices fighting this issue, trying to get him a birth certificate. We finally moved up the bureaucratic ladder enough to find someone who can help us. At last, we reached a slight compromise of Charlesjames Timothy Bundy! We're hoping the US Embassy might be able to help us out with correcting the name on his passport and citizenship paperwork.

Citizenship - Please be in constant prayer for his CRBA (Consulate Report of Birth Abroad which provides US citizenship) and Passport paperwork to process swiftly. The embassy told us and many hundreds of others on a Zoom call that it can take a year to finish this process. We're hoping that since we are both naturalborn US citizens, it might be a little quicker for us.

**Furlough** - This is especially time sensitive and important, as we are excited to publicly announce we are now planning our first furlough for March-October, 2026! We have already scheduled a few meetings and are greatly looking forward to seeing many of you again! 
