Dear Praying Churches and Friends,

I write to you with immense joy and wonderful news from our ministry in Nigeria. The Lord has abundantly blessed us, and I'm pleased to share that my wife is in good health and our children are doing well.

Family Update:

My family is doing okay, and the Lord is blessing us greatly despite the challenges in the country. For the past 4 months, our country has been going through an economic crisis, but through it all, God is good at all times. We celebrated our 10th Wedding Anniversary on February 15th, 2024. It was a moment for my wife and me to think about the goodness of God over the past few years. 10 years were filled with ups and downs, but not without God. Our children are doing fine in their

studies. December through February were filled with celebrations. Connie turned 9 years old on December 31st, Ithiel-James turned 6 years old on February 1, and Candace turned 4 years old on February 21st. God has been so good to us here in Nigeria.

Church Ministry:

Fellowship Baptist Church Akure is doing great; we have seen God working in our midst in a greater way. Our church has been praying for personal revival in the lives of our people, and we have seen the Lord working. We have three Bible college students who graduated from Bible college in January. Two of them are serving at Fellowship Baptist Church, while the third person is the pastor of the new church plant.

The church was able to ordain two men from our church into the gospel ministry. It is a joy for me to see men reach for Christ, surrender to serve God in the ministry, and then be ordained by the church.

Our church went through dark moments in March. It was a devastating moment for us as a church family. My assistant pastor had a baby girl, but unfortunately, after a month in the hospital, the baby died. Also, a faithful church member who had a brief illness died, leaving behind a wife and three small kids.

Our church finally finished our baptistery, and we can now baptize people in the church without going out to look for ponds or rivers for baptism. We were able to baptize 4 believers in both churches.

New Church Plant (Faithway Baptist Church, Ijare):

The new church plant is growing greatly. We have started working on the church building again with the help of a missionary friend here in Nigeria. He has helped

us kickstart the church-building project again, and we are trusting God for more support to complete the work. The church is currently meeting in a school, and the last time I visited, the classroom was not conducive.

Radio Ministry:

Our radio ministry continues to thrive, with numerous salvations and blessings resulting from the preaching of God's Word. We're deeply grateful for the support of several churches that have stood behind this ministry. Your generosity, contributing \$2000 annually and \$500 each quarter, has been instrumental in sustaining our efforts. Thank you for partnering with us as we touch hearts and lives through the airwaves.

Support for Our Men:

Three dedicated men working alongside me in the ministry need support and assistance. While I've been providing monthly support through Help Ministries, I long for a way to fully sustain them. One of these men is married, and the other is preparing for marriage. Securing support for each of them at \$200 per month would significantly ease their financial burdens and enable them to devote themselves to the work of the ministry. We firmly believe that investing in these men will have a lasting impact on the church's growth. Furthermore, we're thrilled to share that in the past five years, five preachers from our church have emerged, and our goal is to send them out to establish churches throughout Nigeria.

In conclusion, we express our deepest gratitude for your faithful prayers and generous support. Your partnership continues to make a tremendous difference in the lives of countless individuals in Nigeria. May the Lord richly bless you for your sacrificial giving and intercession on our behalf.
